3) <u>The Draft Budget</u> (i) Following discussions clerking hours had been amended to include a Clerk /RFO and Assistant Clerk.

(ii)Clerk & RFO salary including car allowance reduced to13hrs per wk at £10.261 /hr Assistant Clerk on 12hrs per wk with lump sum £500/yr car allowance also at £10.261 /hr Making total Clerking budget £15,009.29 (£7,572.86 and £7,436.43 respectively) (iii)A £1,000 contingency sum was also added in.(iv) The £3,000 cost allocated for elections had been removed, if necessary this would be taken from reserves. (v)To cover this budget a Precept of **£38,400.00** would be required. It was noted that Parish Council budgets are not capped at present and that PC's are being devolved increasingly more budgetry items by County and District authorities.

(vi)The Draft Budget was approved and signed for submission to MVDC.
