094. THE MINUTES: Minutes of the meeting on June 16th 2014 were adopted by the Council and signed as a correct record.

095. MATTERS ARISING (from Planning Committee):**1. Min Ref. 8(ii)** Gatwick Coordination Group (GCG) - Crispin Blunt would be contacting District and County Councils on issues regarding a 2nd Gatwick runway – P Garber to coordinate PC's emphasising GB issues, devastation of the countryside, flooding and traffic issues plus lack of a road improvement scheme beyond the local network. The Airports Commission consultation on the schemes for Gatwick and Heathrow will run from mid-October to mid-January 2015. CPC draft response to be ready early Dec.

2. Ref Min.9 Planning Comm.07.07.14: At request of LHAG Messrs Beresford and Garber to meet to discuss result of Europa appeal. Need to know under what legislation matters are determined and what legislation is material to the appeal. Appeal goes back to PINS – not going to Supreme Court. Mr Garber was thanked by the Chairman.

PUBLIC QUESTIONS: Mr T Gillitt, 3 Kettles Cottages, Thurbarns Hill spoke re MO /2014/1009/SCC stating that he is the only consultee who lbstock have a statutory obligation to consult and that none of the other neighbouring residents had been consulted about the application. He considered that the existing Conditions had been breached with working taking place up to and beyond 11pm. Mr Gillitt requested that there be an extension to the consultation period to allow time for the neighbouring properties to be notified and to respond the application.

095a POLICE MATTERS (i) On his appointment Insp. Hamlin had met and discussed local policing issues with Insp. Rundle who had now moved areas. PC Matt Savage would be taking up duties in September; PCSO Pat Booker would be back at work within the next 2 wks; PC Faye Howitt would be working part time with the Dorking Rural West Neighbourhood Support Team; PC Mark Trezise would continue duties patrolling the by- ways with the scrabble bikes and Country Watch would continue as part of the Neighbourhood Policing function.
