- **Response:** The Parish Council objects to the proposed change of use to residential. It is clear that on policy grounds a development must be located in a sustainable location being not more than 600m from a village settlement.

These criteria should apply as a prerequisite to granting any approval. The fact that Mole Valley has approved a proposal does not justify the compounding of non-sustainable development.

Response to Upgrade works to 140600 1752 o2 Existing Radio Base Station Mast Wigmore Lane, Beare Green RH5 4PU:

Councillors agree to the location and the camouflaged mast but consider the design should be more sensitive in this rural location.

**Re consultation on revised plans for MO/2014/1928: Grandon Lodge, RH5 4LT** With regard to the extant planning permission the PC has no objection to the further plans. It should be noted that the PC would not agree to any more extensions and Permitted Development Rights being removed.

**<u>Appeal</u>**: Melville House, Newdigate Road, Beare Green, Dorking, Surrey, RH5 4QD Certificate of lawfulness for an existing use in respect of the breaking of Jaguar cars and sale of resulting components and parts for a period in excess of 10 years – <u>Respond</u> as previous appeal and as with letters submitted in response to MVDC applications.

**075c EUROPA OIL AND GAS Ltd** – <u>SCC Ref: 2014/0082.</u> Chris Collett of Barton Willmore had provided additional details by email regarding the March 2015 Environmental Statement Chapter 12, and Appendix concerning Hydrology and Hydrogeology which have been provided in order to address the level of detail required by the Regulation 22 request for additional information and follow detailed discussions with the Environment Agency. (ii) Decision on Pear Technology: Subsequent to the presentation by Pear Technology at the Annual Meeting (09.03.15) It was agreed that in addition to the advantages pointed out at the presentation it would be a very useful tool for referring to planning applications once the Parish Hall is up and running.

It was agreed in principal to purchase the system but that a further 'hands on' demonstration was required when both Pear and the hosting company Micropane VSM could further demonstrate the product with a final decision being made after that. ## 076B PARISH WEBSITES AND SOCIAL MEDIA

Following on from the Annual Parish Meeting 09.03.15 measures for setting up an alternative Parish web site were progressing with the intention of establishing faster, more detailed two way communications and for capturing more email addresses for wider communications throughout the Parish.

**076C WARD MATTERS-** <u>Beare Green (i) Project OverHall</u> – As of the 17.03.15 £8,936.99 remained from the PC £200,000 available grant funding for Project OverHall (ii) Highways had been asked to replace the damaged wooden posts on the verge opposite the shops and those leading up OH Rd from the northern slip road (iii) Mud in the subway and on the path leading from the A24 through the school field had been cleared.(iv)The school gate at the above location is now kept locked for security reasons. Extending the protective metal barriers along the pavement to the Dukes Head would be costly. Clerk to approach Cllr Clack.(v) BG Pavilion drain / sewer pipe has been unblocked (vi) litter pick on A24 due to take place during march/April. (vii) Clerk reminded to approach Crest re the posts they agreed to install as part of Godwins agreement.
