#### 065d(i) UPDATE ON EUROPA OIL PLATFORM APPEAL

- 1) All of David Boswell's evidence had been submitted to the Inspectorate. This had raised strong issues.
- 2) SCC evidence is very good and addresses the NPPF with regard to mineral extraction and brings out the exceptional circumstances issues and AONB. The three sets of evidence are very strong. It appears difficult to find a reason why PP should be granted.
- 3) Information is still awaited from Coldharbour on the effect on businesses in Coldharbour Lane. David Mir following this up. Businesses must write to the Inspectorate setting out objections and copy in the Clerk + they should also be encouraged to attend the Inquiry.

#### 075e UPDATE ON GODWINS SITE

075e(i) Residents living opposite the site had requested that yellow hatching/Keep Clear be marked on the highway opposite the site entrance. This had been passed to Crest.

075e(ii) A Press Release had been prepared and was agreed by Councillors – (hard copy retained on file). Copy to be placed on the two BG notice boards.

075e(iii) Benefits to Beare Green are included in the Press Release including details of funding towards Project OverHall and safety measures relating to the verge at the northern Beare Green slip road entrance to the A24.

075e(iv) An advance copy of the Press Release would be sent immediately to the Chairman of the Project OverHall (PO).

075e(v) Crest had indicated that they would be prepared to provide professional advice for the PO project.

075e(vi) The Planning application is to be submitted in July

To allow for discussion on the allocation of funds arising from easements it was agreed that the meeting of the Finance Committee planned for Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> September would be brought forward to Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> September in the Committee Room at Capel Village Hall.

#### 076A. FUTURE AVAILABILITY OF PLANNING DOCUMENTS

In response to the proposal that planning documents would not be available (as from July 1<sup>st</sup>) for Parishes to view away from Pippbrook the Clerk to write to Mole Valley planning dept. to the effect that:

- 1) The website must be 100% user friendly allowing access 24/7 with notification given in <u>advance</u> of software updates and closure for maintenance.
- 2) Details of planning applications should be uploaded onto the website in advance of weekly planning updates being released currently some plans do not appear for several days after notification on Thursdays.
- 3) Documents must have the dimensions clearly written on the plans and also have a bar scale on the plans.

Councillors are encouraged to <u>view</u> plans on the MVDC website. Initially the Clerk will download one set of plans per application for each meeting.

#### 076B MAINTENANCE OF CAPEL BURIAL GROUND

- 1) The southern area of the churchyard destined for reburials which has been levelled at PC expense, is not being maintained on a regular basis and requires mowing. The Chairman to discuss with the PCC.
- 2) Removal of spoil would need to be arranged with the Church once burials start on the new site.

#### 076C FURTHER OLYMPICS INFORMATION

Further information had been given on road closures over 28<sup>th</sup>/ 29<sup>th</sup> July. A list was available and copies would be placed in both the Capel shops and in Beare Green and on the website at the beginning of July.

#### **076D HIGHWAYS MATTERS**

1. SCC has issued a notice of its intention to reduce the existing maximum speed limit of 60 MPH imposed in 1996 to a 50MPH maximum speed limit on that length of Dorking Road (A24) Holmwood which extends from its junction with the Holmwood roundabout to the Beare Green roundabout, including the entire length of the circulatory carriageway comprised in the Beare Green roundabout.

SCC also intends to impose a 50 MPH maximum speed limit on that length of the Bognor Road/ Ockley Road (A29), Beare Green which extends from its

junction at the Beare Green Roundabout south-westwards and then southwards to a point 123 metres south-west and then south of the westernmost edge of the carriageway of Henhurst Cross Lane (D297) (at its junction with Bognor Road / Ockley Road A29).

A copy of the proposed Speed Limit Order together with plans showing the roads to which the order relates are available for viewing at the Help Desk in Mole Valley District Council's offices at Pippbrook in Dorking. The objection period expires on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> June.

2. Street Signs

Mole Valley engineers have agreed to repaint the wording and background on the Mortimer Road street name plates. The existing plates will shortly be removed and temporary signs installed during the repainting.

Once the job is complete the Parish Council sports club signs will be updated.

- 3. Flooding along Newdigate Road is due to a blocked drain under the Road, Highways are currently investigating.
- 4. Highways are currently discussing re instatement of verges with Cheetham Hill Contractors.(Capel Street, Wolves Hill and Rusper Road). Councillors requested a speedy reinstatement of the Clarks Green roundabout verge.

#### **076E WARD MATTERS**

<u>Beare Green</u>: (i) Project OverHall – Project is moving forward and there is more agreement on ways of accessing funding. Next committee meeting is on July 10<sup>th</sup>

(ii) Michelle Bransome (Project OverHall Committee) had expressed interest in becoming a Parish Councillor.

Councillors asked whether Project OverHall will be supporting a planning application for the Godwins development.

#### **076F PARISH MAINTENANCE**

- 1 Further emergency works undertaken as a result of the recent storms include:
- 1(i) The ditch under the entrance to 'Driftwood' on Seamans Green has been dredged and repaired resulting in a new section of pipe being concreted under the driveway. The invoice has not been received but the ballpark figure quoted for the work was £500. The resident to be asked to contribute towards the work
- 1(ii) Mr Cox has tidied up a fallen Chestnut branch on the Beare Green.
- 2. Overhanging branches along the pavement between the Surrey Hills Hotel and the intersection with Newdigate Rd need cutting back. Mattree to quote.
